

# Connecting to School Wi-Fi- Chromebooks

Before you can connect to the School Wi-Fi you need to download from the school website the BYOD.txt file, located on the Student Wi-Fi Page. Once this has been downloaded, you will need to rename the file to BYOD.CER.

1. On you Chromebook, open the browser, the type in `chrome://settings/certificates`
2. Select Authorities, the click on import.
3. In the bottom left hand corner of the page that opens, change the drop down from base64-encoded ASCII to all files.
4. Navigate to the location on the Chromebook that you have the BYOD.cer, this may be the downloads folder. Select the file and click open.
5. Open the Wireless settings and click on TGS-Guest.
  - a. Change the EAP Method from LEAP to PEAP
  - b. Change the Server CA certificate from Default to 802.1X CA
  - c. In the box labelled Identify – Enter your username for the school PC's (this is your email address without the @tgschool.net)
  - d. In the box labelled password, enter your school password
  - e. Click connect
