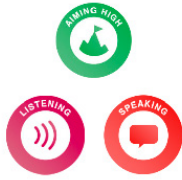
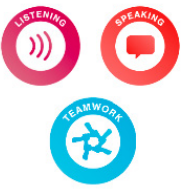


HALF RIBBON FRAMEWORK YEARS 7-9

Students in Years 7-9 can work towards their “Half Ribbon” badges. To receive these they need to have 6 stamps in their folder for each category providing evidence such as certificates, letters from teachers/Heads of House and annotated photographs.

The word “annotate” means to write a few sentences or a short paragraph describing what we are looking at in the photo, for example, “ The photo above is of me playing football/netball, I go to training every week and participate in matches. I have been a member of this team for 3 years and have won the following competitions....”
