LEGO TEC CLUB - with Mr Bentley for years 7 & 8 in room 003 on a Tuesday after school.

Complete a range of theme based technical projects using LEGO.

MATHS CLUB - with Miss Stone for years 7, 8 & 9 in room 119 on a Tuesday after school.

Come along and get support with your homework, additional work on your targetted areas or just play on some Maths games & websites.

MODEL UNITED NATIONS (MUN) - with Mr Hempel for all years in room 202 on a Wednesday after school.

This club provides a scaled down model for the United Nations-an international body for deciding how to tackle foreign and international affairs. Over a course of a month students decide on an issue-for example a disease epidemic or nuclear disarmament- and take on the role of a country. Students research their countries views and history in terms of the issue and produce a policy statement summarising their countries views. Following this students research the issue in more depth and try to lobby the support of other countries. Each topic ends with a debate over the proposed resolutions for the issue.

This is a challenging enrichment club and is suggested for Years 9 and upwards.

MUSIC PRACTICE ROOMS - These are for use during lunchtimes on a Monday, Wednesday or Thursday. You will need to see MUL at break time on the day you wish to book the room for lunchtime use.

The club will also help students develop skills needed for the new GCSE Literature exam. Suitable for Year 9-13 students.

READING CLUB - with Mrs Coombe in room 310 on a Thursday after school.

We would like all students to have a love of reading. We look at different book titles and then as a group decide which book we would like to read. Some students come along who just like to listen to a story being read. Others like to join in and read to the group. We look at any new vocabulary that comes out and build up a little word bank.

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Once the book is finished we discuss it, rate it and sometimes write a little book review.
