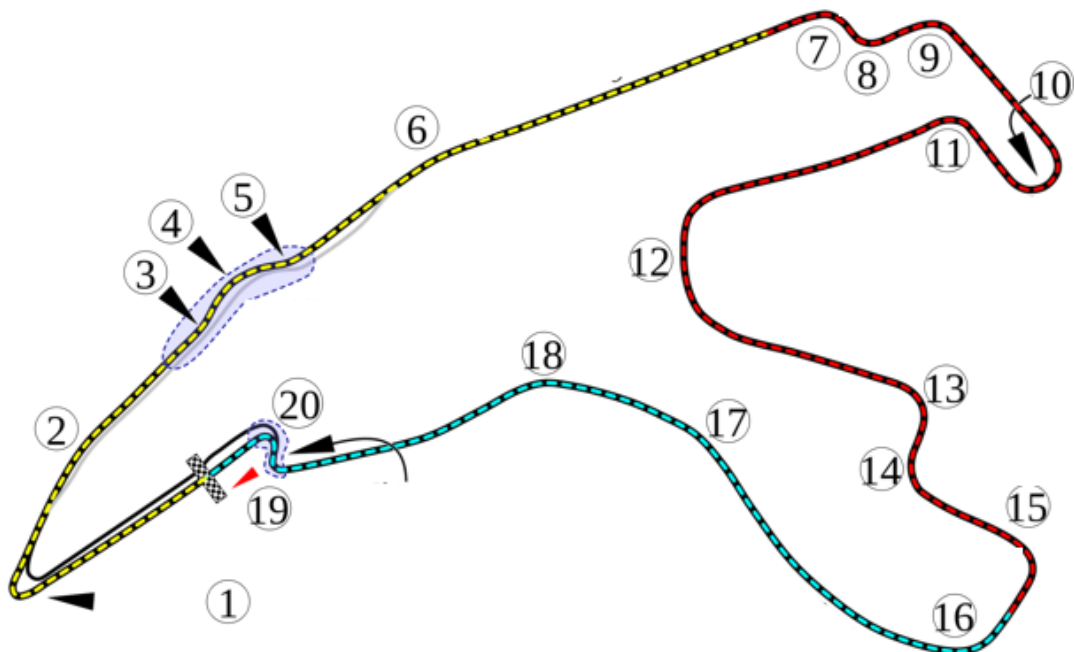

Summer Term Key Dates:

English Language:
